

Your vs you're

Your means **belonging to you**, or **of you**.

You're is a contraction of **you are**.

Tip: when you see an apostrophe, you can usually expand the word.

're → are

Examples

You're late. (**You are** late.)

Your problem. (The problem **belongs to you**.)

You're your own worst enemy. (**You are** the worst enemy **of you**.)
